

## Lambayeque Quecha Translation Update

With a population of 20,000 speakers, the Lambayeque Quecha language group can now worship God in their heart language! The New Testament Dedication occurred Aug. 19, 2005, featuring a parade, music and feasting. During the dedication, two white doves, symbolizing the two areas where the language is spoken, were released.

Pray the Lambayeque Quecha speakers will read, believe and obey God's Word.

Also pray for the Huaylas Quecha New Testament, which is expected to be completed and dedicated in 2007. Workers are in their final revision of the New Testament, and estimate it will take about six months. Once this New Testament is completed, 336,000 more people will have access to God's Word in their heart language.
